I WANT TO FIND A THESIS

1. Theses defended after the year 2005 are available only in electronic form in the digital library of TBU theses at <http://digilib.k.utb.cz>.
2. Older theses are stored in printed version in the archive. It is necessary to submit a request through the Library catalogue at <http://katalog.k.utb.cz>. You can borrow them only for in house use in the study room on the 3rd floor.
3. You can browse theses in the digital library by community, author, subject, date of submission etc.
4. In the catalogue item record, pay attention to the **Availability** field highlighted in red.
5. You can download the fulltexts of publicly accessible theses even without logging in. If the access to fulltext is limited by its licence, e.g. only for users from TBU – **Availability: pouze v rámci univerzity**, you must be logged in to browse those theses. The user name and password is the same as for Stag.
6. The access to full texts is sometimes **time-limited** (the theses will be accessible after certain date). In this case it is unfortunately impossible to get the access (the only option is the contact the author).
7. If the thesis is available, you can immediately download the fulltext in PDF and the supervisor's and oponent's reviews. Any eventual attachments are always stored in a zip file.
