- 1. If you are neither a student or an employee of the university, you can browse only free available theses without logging in the digital library.
- 2. Theses defended before 2005 and available in printed form in the archive are to be used only within the library, in the study room on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor.

If you need help, don't hesitate to ask our librarians at the lending desk on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor or at the reference desk on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor.

## I WANT TO FIND A THESIS

- Theses defended after the year 2005 are available only in electronic form in the digital library of TBU theses at http://digilib.k.utb.cz.
- Older theses are stored in printed version in the archive. It is necessary to submit a request through the Library catalogue at http://katalog.k.utb.cz.
  You can borrow them only for in house use in the study room on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor.
- 3. You can browse theses in the digital library by community, author, subject, date of submission etc.
- 4. In the catalogue item record, pay attention to the Availability field highlighted in red.

- You can download the fulltexts of publicly accessible theses even without logging in. If the access to fulltext is limited by its licence, e.g. only for users from TBU – Availability: pouze v rámci univerzity, you must be logged in to browse those theses. The user name and password is the same as for Stag.
- 6. The access to full texts is sometimes time-limited (the theses will be accessible after certain date). In this case it is unfortunately impossible to get the access (the only option is the contact the author).
- 7. If the thesis is available, you can immediately download the fulltext in PDF and the supervisor's and oponent's reviews. Any eventual attachments are always stored in a zip file.
